Additional Information

Q: Is a parent or legal guardian required to be present for minors?

A: A parent or legal guardian is required to be present for anyone under the age of 16 years. The parent or legal guardian for anyone under the age of 18 <u>must</u> sign the completed consent form.

Q: What should I bring with me to the mobile clinic?

A: Print and complete the <u>COVID-19 vaccination screener and consent form</u>, and bring the completed form to your appointment. A form will be provided if you are not able to complete one prior to your visit. Also, please bring a photo ID such as a driver's license or passport, but other items, such as a student ID, are also accepted. If you have health insurance, you should also bring a copy of your pharmacy insurance card.

Q: Does getting a vaccine cost anything?

A: No. Vaccines are administered at no cost to all members of the community. If you have health insurance, El Camino Hospital Outpatient Pharmacy will bill your insurance company for the cost of administration, but this cost will never be passed on to you.

Q: What vaccine will be available at the mobile clinic?

A: We will provide 1st doses, 2nd doses, or booster doses of **Pfizer for (12 years and older)**, and **Moderna for (18 years and older)**. In addition, we will provide 1st dose or 2nd dose of **Pfizer for (5 Through 11 years of age)**.

Q: How will I receive my second dose?

A: We will schedule your appointment at El Camino Hospital Outpatient Pharmacy located at 2500 Grant Road, Suite 1B20. Mountain View, CA 94040.

Q: Can I come to this clinic to receive my SECOND dose if I have received my first dose somewhere else?

A: Yes, you can. Please bring your CDC vaccine card and/or any other documentation from your first dose. It has to be at least 21 days since your initial Pfizer dose, or at least 28 days since your initial Moderna dose to be eligible to receive your second dose.

Q: Can I come to this clinic to receive my BOOSTER dose if I have received my first two dose somewhere else?

A: Yes, if you are **12 years and older**. Please bring your CDC vaccine card and/or any other documentation from your initial primary dose(s) completion. It has to be at least 5 months since the completion of your second dose of Pfizer/Moderna dose OR at least 2 months since the completion of your initial dose of Johnson & Johnson dose.
